Duo Catanza combines the forces of guitarists Scott Plato and Matthias Young and brings to the stage music throughout the centuries. Scott holds a Master's of Music from Adams State University and is the Head of Guitar at Gordon State College. He is endorsed by D'Addario Strings and LoPrinzi Guitars. Matthias received his Bachelor of Music from Georgia State University and is the Director of the Dunwoody Conservatory of Music. He is endorsed by Aiersi Guitars.

The name, Duo Catanza is reflective of their heritage. Scott's family immigrated to the United States from Catanzaro, Italy, which is known as the "City of the Two Seas." A shortened version, Catanza was formed. As Matthias has Germanic heritage, it was fitting as the name highlights the word, *tanz*, which is German for a musical dance. Thus, Duo Catanza was created.
